Multiple sign postings cannot be more than three hundred (300) feet apart. If the subject parcel(s) abut more than one(1) street, notices shall be posted along each street. When the subject parcel(s) does not front a public road, the sign shall be posted at the point on a public road by which the property is, or can be, reached.

You must maintain the sign(s) in good readable condition. If the said sign is destroyed, lost, or becomes unreadable, you or your representative shall obtain a replacement sign from the Growth Management Division. Any sign posted in accordance with these requirements shall be removed from the property and disposed of by the applicant or applicant's representative not later than 24 hours following the final decision by the Board of County Commissioners, Planning Commission, or Board of Adjustment.
