# FAQs

#### What is the purpose of this meeting?

The purpose of the meeting is to update residents and property owners in Narcoossee of proposed changes to the Historic Town Center overlay.

#### What is the format of the meeting?

This meeting will be held in an open house style format where attendees can interact with exhibits of proposed changes and participate in discussion about the proposed land use and code changes to provide feedback.

#### How does this impact existing development?

The changes would not affect existing uses unless new development is proposed within the amended areas of the Historic Town Center. New development is defined in the Land Development Code and generally includes construction on vacant land, new subdivisions, and building expansions in excess of 5%.

#### Development is not being proposed.

#### How does this impact future development?

Future new development will have to abide by any policy and code changes adopted by the Board at public hearings. This includes permitted uses, use restrictions, setbacks, buffers, building height, etc.
