


Request: Amend the text of the Future Land Use Element (FLUE) and Transportation Element (TRNE), including FLUE Policy 1.7.3, FLUE Policy 1.7.4, FLUE Policy 5.1.5, TRNE Policy 1.10.6., and modify Map TRN 10 to ensure compatibility with the training and operational missions of the Avon Park Air Force Range, military installation, pursuant to Section163.3175 and 163.3177, F.S.

<u>Requested Action</u>: Approval to transmit CPA12-0001 to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for interagency review, and to recommend approval of the JLUS 2012 as part of this Comprehensive Plan Amendment.

APAFR Commander's Comments dated Received June 4, 2012

- 1. <u>August 2010 JLUS</u>: JLUS 2012 should be an update or supplement to the August 2010 JLUS rather than a replacement.
- <u>RESPONSE</u>: JLUS 2012 is not an amendment, but may be considered a supplement. Staff will make revisions to the staff report.
- 2. <u>MBZ Noise Area <115 DB</u>: Land areas impacted by blast noise up to 115db. should be included in the amendment to Map TRN10.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: Pursuant to Future Land Use Policy 1.10.7, Military blast noise up to 115 db is not applicable to use of land or transportation planning, therefore, should not be included on TRN Map 10.

Lighting standards: Include lighting standards in the JLUS 2012, and confirm if the USAF Human Factors Expert had provided any recommended lighting standards to adopt.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: Lighting standards will be further addressed upon receipt of information from Captain Zachary Garrett, USAF Human Factors Expert.

APAFR Commander's Comments dated Received June 4, 2012

- 4. Landfills: Confirm if Landfills addressed in the JLUS 2012.
- RESPONSE: Landfills and Bird Aircraft Strike Hazards (BASH) are addressed in Section 3 of the JLUS. Conditional Use Site Standards (CUSS) have been added to Appendix D. <u>Staff will</u> add New Recommendation #7. which will outline addition of a CUSS that require notice to and compatibility with the APAFR for new landfill sites locating within a MOA or Restricted Air Spare Space
- 5. <u>Buffering</u>: Confirm Osceola County's interest in buffering, conservation and REPI conservation funding programs.



RESPONSE: Osceola County supports conservation buffers (see Recommendation #5), but the County is not physically adjacent to the base and unable to provide physical buffers (trees, fencing, shrubs, etc.). Staff will revise Page 23 of LLUS 2012 to clarify support for REPI and other conservation programs.

APAFR Commander's Comments dated Received June 4, 2012

 <u>Wind Farms</u>: Include within JLUS 2012 recommendations that wind farms proposed within a MOA require a detailed study regarding the impact on range flight and radar training operations.

<u>RESPONSE</u>: Wind farms should be addressed on a case-by case basis through the current zoning and FAA review processes. <u>Staff will add New</u> <u>Recommendation #7</u>, which will outline addition of a CUSS that require notice to and compatibility with the APAFR for wind farm sites locating within a MOA or Restricted Air Space

7. Landing Fields: Clarification regarding Class I and Class II aircraft landing fields in the AC Zoning district.



<u>RESPONSE</u>: Class I and Class II landing fields, if any proposed, should be addressed on a case-by case basis through the current zoning and FAA review processes. Conditional Use Site Standards (CUSS) Recommendation #7, which will outline addition of a CUSS that require notice to and compatibility with the APAFR for new landing field sites locating within a MOA or Restricted Air Space.
